The only persons that are eligible to submit bids are owners of contiguous parcels or a holder of record of either a predominant easement or right-of-way

Bidders are required to preregister at www.govease. com/los-angeles and submit a deposit of 10 percent of the spend limit that is set by each registered bidder. Bid deposits must be in the form of a wire transfer, cashier's check, or bankissued money order at the time of registration. Registration will begin on Friday, November 22, 2024, at 8:00 a.m. Pacific Time and end on Thursday, December 12, 2024, at 1:00 p.m.

Pursuant to R&TC Section 3692.3, the TTC sells all properties "as is" and the County and its employees are not liable for any known or unknown conditions of the properties, including, but not limited to, errors in the records of the Office of the Assessor (Assessor) pertaining to improvement of the property.

If the TTC sells a property, parties of interest, as defined by R&TC Section 4675, have a right to file a claim with the County for any proceeds from the sale, which are in excess of the liens and costs required to be paid from the proceeds. If there are any excess proceeds after the application of the minimum bid, the TTC will send no-tice to all parties of interest, pursuant to law.
